With the aim of providing students an opportunity to make a positive impact on the environment and complete their community service hours in a meaningful way, we created the *Little Litter Ridders* program. This program engages students and helps them to build environmental awareness through the collection of litter and excess waste in their communities.

Safety is our top priority. Students must agree to respect the following rules throughout their participation in the program:

1. Students must protect themselves at all times using the supplied protective equipment.
2. Students will wear the clothing provided at all times.
3. Students will collect litter in a neighbourhood that is familiar to them.
4. Students will operate in groups of at least two people. Partners may include fellow students, friends, or guardians.
5. Students shall use their discretion to collect only 'safe' litter. Do not collect anything that poses danger to health including sharp objects, toxic materials, or liquids.
6. Students shall undergo a dedicated training session to learn how to use & maintain the provided equipment.
7. Students shall report their hours to Kelly McCaig at Viking Recycling promptly.

Last, but certainly not least, participation in the *Little Litter Ridders* program requires that each student pledge to never knowingly litter nor sit idly by as friends, relatives, or other acquaintances commit acts of littering.
